#### **Ballet II-IV, Pointe IV**

**Robert Moore**, a native of Indiana, began his dance training at the age of ten with the White River Ballet School in Noblesville, IN. Moore continued his training, receiving a full scholarship to the Harid Conservatory in Boca Raton, Florida. Moore started his professional career with the Boston Ballet. After nine successful years with Boston Ballet, he joined the Pittsburgh Ballet Theatre in 2006 as a soloist where he was the first American to dance the lead role in John Neumeier's ballet "Street Car Named Desire". In 2014 he accepted a principal position with the Smuin Ballet Company in San Francisco, CA where he furthered his contemporary element in ballet. Moore's Repertoire includes many lead roles in works by Balanchine, Cranko, Kylian, Neumeier, MacMillan, Christopher Wheeldon, Val Caniparoli, Mark Morris, Twyla Tharp, Paul Taylor, Helen Picket, and Ben Stevenson. In 2004 Robert, was invited to dance the lead role in John Cranko's, Onegin, with the Teatro Municipal in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Moore has had the pleasure of working with such director's as: Bruce Marks, Anna Marie Holmes, Miko Nissenen, Richard Cragun, Terrence Orr, and Celia Fushille

#### Jazz II-IV, Tap & Musical Theater

**Felix LaBella III** currently is the resident Director/Choreographer and Production Show Supervisor for Norwegian Cruise Line and Oceania Cruises, where he has also performed as a principal singer/dancer and dance captain. National and international touring credits include 42nd Street (Broadway Revival), Oklahoma (Dance Captain, 1<sup>st</sup> National Broadway Revival) and CATS. Regional theater: Around the World in 80 Days (World Premiere, Fulton Opera House), West Side Story, A Chorus Line, Crazy for You, Sweet Charity, national TV commercials, guest artist with Cohesion Dance Project's "Nutcracker on the Rocks". Directing/Choreography: "Oklahoma!" (Naples Players & Venice Little Theater). Felix has taught and continues to teach master classes for studios and colleges across the country including the Alvin Ailey Extension, Jeanette Neill Dance Boston, Arizona State University, Princeton Ballet Academy and is currently a visiting guest faculty member for Dance Works Studio in Utica, NY. Originally from New Hartford, NY, he now calls NYC and Tampa, FL home.

#### Modern IV

**Nicole Wolcott** has been called "One of today's finest dance comedians and a knockout dancer," by the New York Times. She has enjoyed a great career with dance companies, rock bands and video artists around the country and was the subject of a feature article in DANCE TEACHER magazine. In 2003 Nicole co-founded KEIGWIN + COMPANY with Larry Keigwin and was the Associate Artistic Director and a featured dancer for ten years. Nicole is now the Education Director for the company and continues to assist on a variety of projects outside of the company's framework; most recently as the Associate Choreographer for the Broadway production of If/Then starring Idina Menzel and Anthony Rapp. She teaches at private studios and universities in New York City including NYU and Princeton as well as traveling the country as a guest artist. Wolcott's own choreography has been performed in New York City at a range of venues from The Joyce Theater to CBGB's and around the country at Summerdance Santa Barbara, Bates Dance Festival, and the Kennedy Center. Most recently she finished an evening length solo titled PaperPieces. Sarah also works as a youth counselor with unaccompanied Latino youth. Her dream is to utilize dance and movement as a form of healing and empowerment for youth and their families.

#### **Improvisation**

**Julynn Wilderson** holds a BA in Anthropology and Dance from Bard College at Simon's Rock and currently teaches and works for Cohesion Dance Project. Her early and pre-professional training incorporated a diversity of movement disciplines including Feldenkrais method, Bartenieff Fundamentals, modern, RAD ballet, and creative movement. Further training through Simon's Rock and Columbia College Chicago introduced her to contact improvisation, butoh, and interdisciplinary media. She has collaborated as a choreographer, dancer, and media consultant on work presented at theaters, galleries, and studios. In her free time, she loves to spend time outdoors, see new places, play music, and make art

**Amber Moon Peterson** started her dance career with Keshet Dance Company in her hometown of Albuquerque, New Mexico. She graduated from Keshet's Pre-Professional program in 2007, with her focus primarily in Modern and Ballet and was a repertory dancer there until 2009. She then lived in the Long Beach and Los Angeles area from 2009-2015 where she studied under Stephanie Powell and danced with Datugan Dance Theater in 2010. She performed in dance festivals across Southern California including Mixmatch Dance Festival, San Diego Dance Festival, and the Kennith Walker Dance Project. In 2015 she moved to Portland, Oregon. Since 2013 she has been involved with Cohesion Dance Project acting as Rehearsal Director and Guest Artist for *Nutcracker on the Rocks* and is delighted to have recently moved to Helena Montana to work with CDP and be creating and teaching dance. She is passionate about dance as an art form, and the arts in general and enjoys educating dancers as well as continuing her own growth and learning as an active dancer.

**Nina Murphy** has finished her first year of dance training at the University of Wyoming, where she has recently been accepted into the BFA program. She has studied vertical dance and is looking forward to performing on the Vedauwoo cliffs near Laramie Wyoming in August. - All other classes: Appropriate shoes, tops that cover the midriff and pants/tights that cover the legs at least to the knees.


